
BIODYNAMIC FARMING AND WINEMAKING

Our approach to winemaking begins in the vineyard. Like our farms, our wineries are both Organically certified by CCOF and Demetercertified Biodynamic. We strive to create the finest wines possible with the least amount of intervention, chemicals, additives, or ingredients. Our goal is to allow the grapes to develop into the purest wine possible, letting the essential flavors of the vineyard be expressed most clearly. Biodynamic® agriculture (some referring to it as organics 2.0), as a whole can be summed up as

a sustainable, holistic approach to farming that utilizes organic, locally sourced materials for practices and farming methods focus on creating healthy soil by restoring and enhancing ecological harmony and avoiding the use of chemical fertilizers.

COWHORN VINEYARD & GARDEN

A certified Biodynamic and Organic farming system, Cowhorn Vineyard & Garden is nestled in the fertile Applegate Valley of southern Oregon. Being just a few miles north of the California border, this property is ideally suited for Syrah and the Northern Rhone varieties. Cowhorn has always been nature-focused, farming in harmony with the ecosystem as a whole provides a sitespecific wine that represents a sense of time and place. Vinified using a low intervention approach, the result is an unmistakable wine that reflects the healthy, nutrient rich vineyard from which it comes.







Located in Oregon's Willamette Valley, within the Van Duzer Corridor AVA, Johan Vineyards is an 85-acre certified-Biodynamic® and organic Estate winery. The focus is on growing cool climate varieties such as Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Gris and Zweigelt. Johan maintains a long-term view both in the vineyard and the cellar, nurturing a healthy, diverse microbiological system in our soil and producing wines that are alive and capable of evolving over many years.




THE 'BIG' WHY

A VIRGINIA NORTON WINE WAS EVEN NAMED "BEST RED WINE OF ALL NATIONS" AT THE VIENNA WORLD'S FAIR IN 1873, AND WAS AWARDED A GOLD MEDAL AT THE PARIS WORLD'S FAIR OF 1889 – THE YEAR THE EIFFEL TOWER WAS CONSTRUCTED.

Virginians have made wine for more than four centuries. The Jamestown settlers had hoped that Virginia would become a major source of wine for the British Empire. They signed a law that required each male settler to plant and tend at least 10 grape vines. Little came of this because every effort to grow vinifera, or vines of European origin, met with failure from an unknown pest, Phylloxera, as well as disease due to the new environment. The booming tobacco trade soon diluted British interest in the possibilities of American wine, and the American settlers themselves lost interest. While fine wine could be had only from European suppliers, whiskey, beer and brandy were plentiful.

In hopes of one day realizing the promise of fine Virginia wines, Thomas Jefferson cultivated European grapes for more than 30 years. His Monticello vineyards, however, never produced a single bottle of wine. He wasn't alone in trying. After 11 years of efforts at Mount Vernon, George Washington, too, had nothing to show for his work. In the 1820s, wines made from Native American grapes met with great success. Also, the late 1800s discovery that native and European vines could be grafted gave Virginia's nascent wine industry a lift. In the early 20th century,

Prohibition promptly brought wine production to a standstill. The industry was slow to bounce back. Some 17 years after Prohibition's repeal, Virginia still had only 15 acres of commercial wine grapes.

In the late-1950s experimental planting of vinifera showed promise. With the establishment of six new wineries in the 1970s, the recovery was officially underway. A renewed effort to grow an European Chardonnay succeeded at the Waverly Estate in Middleburg in 1973. Then in 1976, Italian pioneer vintner Gianni Zonin hired Gabriele Rausse to grow and harvest vinifera grapes near Charlottesville.

He established Barboursville Vineyards and helped other vinters do the same. By 1995 Virginia had 46 wineries, by 2005, 107. At over 300 wineries and counting, today only California, New York, Oregon and Washington have more wineries than Virginia. The persistence of generations of winemakers is paying off, and the vision of one of Virginia's most renowned native sons, Thomas Jefferson, is now coming true.

Barboursville is a magnificent and historic estate located between Monticello and Montpelier. It is home to Virginia's most honored winery, founded in 1976 by the Zonin Family, who have been prominent in Italian viticulture since 1821.

Defying the unanimous advice of many people to plant tobacco at Barboursville, Gianni Zonin – heir to a family wine enterprise in the Veneto – acquired Barboursville plantation with the seemingly ridiculous expectation of creating a vineyard.

Jefferson had attempted this, persisting into the 19th Century at Monticello, always failing to achieve a single harvest. He would be pleased that wine is being produced at his neighboring plantation, home to a dear friend and for whom he designed the

Because of Gianni Zonin and Luca Pachina, the resident winemaker since 1990, Barboursville has been drawn totally into the wine world's embrace, and inspired hundreds to follow their example. Celebrating the winery's 40th anniversary in 2016, they continue to set the standard for Virginia now populated with more than 300 wineries. Barboursville produces Octagon, the most renowned red wine of Virginia.

Chatham Vineyards on Church Creek

The land at Chatham, which overlooks Church Creek, was patented in 1640. The Federal-period brick house, Chatham, was built in 1818. The historic outbuildings, barns and two early 1900s homes on the property have been renovated in recent years. Chatham Farm has been a working farm for four centuries.

Since 1999 more than 20 acres of high-density (1,740 vines per acre) French vinifera varietals have been planted. They are Merlot, Chardonnay and California Cabernet Franc rootstock, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot. The vineyards are cane pruned during the winter months to balance the vines and limit yields to less than four tons per acre thereby concentrating wine flavors. The grapes are handpicked and sorted before pressing to ensure the highest quality of the juice. Grapes not vinified at the winery are sold to other wineries in Virginia.

The winery was constructed in 2005 and currently has a production capacity of 3,000 to 5,000 cases annually. Temperature in the winery is maintained at 50 degrees year round. A retail tasting room is located in the winery.

Thibaut-Janisson was born from a long friendship that began in a Grand Cru village in the Champagne region of France. Thibaut and his friend Manuel Janisson, both from champagne-producing families in the town, started in the family businesses at a young age. When Thibaut came to work in California in 1983, he had already spent a few years working in Australia. Thibaut arranged for Janisson to come work with him in California and the two young men began talking of one day producing a sparkling wine together. About 25 years later, they agreed that Virginia would be the place to do it.

Thibaut came to Charlottesville in 2003 to consult at Kluge Estate Winery. In 2005 after seeing the potential for Virginia sparkling wine, Thibaut and Janisson began their joint venture and in 2007 they had the first release of their nonvintage Blanc de Chardonnay. Virginia Fizz, a sparkling wine, followed in Spring 2011.

Both wines are produced at Veritas Winery in Afton, Virginia, west of Charlottesville.

A passion for fine wine and sustainable working lands drove Tayloe and Suzy Dameron to open Upper Shirley Vineyards, a state-of-the-art winery in the cradle of American history. The vineyards are nestled alongside the gently flowing James River with breathtaking views of the Presquile National Wildlife Refuge, a 1,329-acre island bird sanctuary. Upper Shirley Vineyards welcomes guests to its beautiful 14,000-square-foot Low Country winery to taste its wines, enjoy Chef Carlisle Bannister's fine Southern cooking and celebrate life in the warm embrace of Tidewater Virginia.

At Upper Shirley Vineyards, they think of a great wine grape as a balance between complex flavors, sugars, acids and more.

They believe they stand the best chance of finding that elusive balance with their intentional lack of mechanization and by nurturing each individual vine, one at a time, as often as six times a year, all 12.000 of them.

Established in 2013, Upper Shirley Vineyards has 19 acres under vine consisting of merlot, petit verdot, tannat and viognier, with plans to expand. They diligently selected varieties of European vitis vinifera grapes to match their terroir.

In 1999 Andrew and Patricia Hobson bought Saddleback Farm near Afton, which at the time was a simple horse and cattle farm. Patricia saw the potential in the land and planted several acres of grapes with a wish and prayer. By 2001 they had their first vintage ready for production. That year Andrew tried his hand at winemaking with great success and their love for the Virginia wine industry blossomed.

Since then the Hobsons have worked tirelessly to expand on their vision. The business is truly a family affair as they have been joined by all three of their children in the running and development of the business. Their philosophy is to make wine with the classic, old-world principles of viticulture and vinication, at the same time using state of the art technology to capture varietal and regional character. Their name derives from the Roman historian Pliny the Elder's observation "In Vino Veritas" - "In Wine there is Truth." They believe that the truth in their wine comes straight from their vineyard as an expression of the land where they live and work.

2013 Purlieu Cabernet Sauvignon (2 bottles)

"The 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon Purlieu was aged in 70% new French oak for 22 months. This just has a Napa appellation, but is very concentrated -- even profoundly so -- and I have to argue that it's even deeper, richer and potentially even finer than the Martinez Vineyard from Pritchard Hill. Very long, impressive and intense, this looks to be a great value in the scheme of Napa Cabernet pricing. It is also no shy wine at 15.5% alcohol. This is a big-time sleeper of the vintage. A 26-acre vineyard managed by superstar viticulturist David Abreu. Kristine Ashe, a grower for ten years, finally decided to estate bottle her wines in 2007. The winery closed in 2020 but received high scores for her releases including the 2013, which was their last release. **CT 93**

2013 JCB by Jean-Charles Boisset No. 10 Cabernet Sauvignon (2 bottles)

"Another majestic effort from Boisset is the 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon JCB No. 10. This is 90% Cabernet Sauvignon from Oakville and 10% Petit Verdot. This is a stunner and there are 235 cases of this unfiltered classic. Drink it over the next ten or more years." **RP 95+**

2013 Far Niente Estate Bottled Cabernet Sauvignon (2 bottles)

"Sourced largely from the Martin Stelling Vineyard behind the winery in the western shade of Oakville, this wine opens with charred oak and a smoky, meaty character that intrigues. Seamless on the palate in soft, perceptible tannin, it delves into characteristics of cedar and brushy sage as it goes, unveiling a wildness that's hard to contain." **WE 95**

AMAZING BURGUNDY FROM THE BOWERS CELLAR

Joseph Drouhin is one of Burgundy's most important wine producers. Founded in Beaune in 1880, the domaine has expanded throughout the 20th Century to include vineyards in Chablis, the Côte de Nuits, the Côte de Beaune and the Côte Chalonnaise, making everything from simple, village-level cuvées to highly priced grand cru and premier cru wines from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

The domaine was started by the eponymous Drouhin, who established the company's headquarters in the city of Beaune in the late 19th Century. His son, Maurice, began to acquire vineyards in the early 20th Century, starting with the now-iconic Clos des Mouches vineyard. Throughout the 1950s and 1960s Joseph Drouhin began to expand its land holdings in Chablis and, in 1988, the domaine established a vineyard in Oregon, in the United States.

"Shy aromatically, this rich, silky red boasts incisive smoke- and spice-tinged cherry flavors on a harmonious frame. Appealing now, but requires time to reveal its class and depth. Fine length. Best from 2015 through 2032. 27 cases imported." **WS 92**

The color remains a healthy, even opaque bluish/purple, but there is no reason to hesitate to drink it. It should evolve for another 30-40 years, so there is no hurry either. On the palate, it's full-bodied, deep and concentrated, with a rich chassis of satiny structuring tannins and a layered, umami-laden core of fruit. At 13.6% alcohol, it's also beautifully balanced. 2013 No Girls La Placiencia Vineyard Grenache

"This wine is getting up there with some of the top Grenache releases to come out of the New World. The buzz words here are perfume, complexity and elegance. It's also worth noting that the Grenache vines for this wine come from the famed Rayas lieu-dit in Chateauneuf du Pape." **RP 95**

2014 Schrader Cellars RBS Beckstoffer To Kalon Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

"The 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon RBS is made from the same clone (337) as the Georges III, but comes from the To Kalon Vineyard in Oakville and not the Rutherford Georges III. It has fabulous concentration, notes of incense, licorice, blackcurrants, blackberries, as well as spring flowers. The wine is juicy, savory and full-bodied, with wonderful underlying energy and freshness. This wine is a more forward style than we saw with the 2013's, and is best drunk over the next 16-20 years. Drink 2016-2036." **RP 96**




"Having had both this and the 2001 Harlan, this is not the same as the 2001 Harlan. Not quite as good but still excellent. Less oak, more spice. Nose is powerful, slightly sweet smelling. Rich mouthfeel with some similarities to Harlan with the round and sweet fruits and feel of the early mid-palate. Long finish and this wine still has good acidity. Clearly Napa in origin but has some Saint-Estephe flavor similarities, especially on the finish. I think it is the spice flavors they have in common. This wine is balanced and the tannins are well integrated." **CT 95**

1994 Shafer Cabernet Sauvignon Hillside Select (3 bottles)

"A spectacular wine, the 1994 Shafer Cabernet Sauvignon Hillside Select begins a succession of profound Hillside Select cuvées that continues nearly uninterrupted (1996 misses slightly) to the present day. It is a further indication of just how impressive this team's performance has been at this winery. The fully mature 1994, which has another 15-20 years of drinkability ahead of it, exhibits a complex, nearly flamboyant nose of subtle oak, blue, red and black fruits, graphite and licorice. Vérité Winery is a wine producer based in Sonoma County in California. It is most famous for its three Bordeaux-styled blends: La Muse, La Joie, and Le Désir, which have all received 100-point scores from American wine critic Robert Parker over several vintages.

2012 Vérité La Muse

"The 2012 La Muse, which is 85% Merlot, 11% Cabernet Franc and 4% Malbec, is a smaller cuvée of 1,840 cases. The wine has plenty of spice box, cedar wood, Christmas fruitcake and Asian plum sauce, along with black cherry and blackcurrant fruit. Ripe, round, full-bodied and opulent, this is a wine that can be drunk now or cellared for another three decades. Drink 2015-2045." **RP 97**

2012 Vérité La Joie

"The 2012 La Joie, which is a blend of 76% Cabernet, 12% Merlot, 8% Cabernet Franc and 4% Petit Verdot, blew me away. A profound effort, with 55% of it coming from Hillsides in Alexander Valley, 31% from Knights Valley and the balance from Chalk Hill, the wine shows great minerality, oodles of créme de cassis fruit, incense, licorice, crushed rock, and a provocative full-throttle mouthfeel. A wine of great intensity, purity and equilibrium, this definitely begs for 4-7 years of bottle aging and should drink well for at least 30+ years. Drink 2020-2050." **RP 100**

2012 Vérité Le Desir

"The 2012 Le Desir reminds me of a young vintage of Ausone, such as 2005. The wine has amazing minerality and an explosive blueberry nose intermixed with blackberries, new saddle leather, charcoal and camphor. It is full-bodied, with espresso notes emerging on the palate. There are 1,900 cases of this super-endowed, prodigious wine that should drink well for 35-40 years. How fun it would be for megamillionaires to put this in a blind tasting of a great vintage of Ausone in 10, 20 or 30 years from now. Drink 2015-2055." **RP 100**

2019 Vérité La Muse

"The 2019 La Muse is a blend of 90% Merlot, 5% Cab Franc and 5% Malbec. Deep ruby-purple, it explodes with cassis, violets and aniseed, with wafts of thyme, tobacco and iron, offering new nuances with each return to the glass. The full-bodied palate is powerful and refined, with loads of rounded tannins, focused freshness and ethereal character. It's exceptionally expressive and structured and should be very long lived in the cellar. Drink 2024-2044." **RP 99**

2019 Vérité La Joie

"The 2019 La Joie is an elegant expression that offers power, freshness and expressive, floral character. A blend of 84% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc and 4% Petit Verdot, it has a deep ruby color and opens slowly from black cherries and blueberries to accents of violets, ground coffee and licorice. The full-bodied palate has generous, grainy tannins, detailed, perfumed flavors and bright acidity, finishing with an alluring iron character. Drink 2024-2044." **RP 99**

2019 Vérité Le Desir

"The 2019 Le Désir is an exceptional blend of 83% Cabernet Franc, 8% Merlot, 5% Malbec and 4% Cabernet Sauvignon, offering complex, layered flavors, soaring aromatics and very detailed expression. Deep ruby-purple in color, its aromas unfold slowly and offer new nuances with each return to the glass: Morello cherries, warm chocolate, dried thyme, desiccated roses and dried herbs. The full-bodied palate offers concentrated, floral fruits, pixelated tannins, bursts of fresh acidity and a very long finish with layer after layer of detailed flavor. Drink 2024-2044." **RP 100**


Clos de Tart is a highly esteemed domaine based on a single grand cru monopole vineyard in the commune of Morey-Saint-Denis, in the Côte de Nuits subregion of Burgundy's Côte d'Or. The estate produces two wines, both from Pinot Noir.

2006 Domaine du Clos de Tart 'Clos de Tart' Grand Cru Monopole

"Tasted at the pre-dinner vertical to mark Sylvain Pitiot's retirement from the domaine, the 2006 Clos de Tart Grand Cru has a deep, intense nose with plenty of dark berry fruit (blackberry and boysenberry), mixed with cedar and licorice scents. Saturnine at first, it responds to aeration, opening up with minimal encouragement and gaining more and more intensity. The palate is what you might call a bold and brassy style of Clos de Tart - upfront fruit, muscular, forthright tannin and enormous depth on the finish that fans out gloriously. Think of a blast of trumpets in the Albert Hall and you've got this wine. Immense! Drink 2017-2040." **RP 96**

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2012 BOND TERROIR PORTFOLIO IN OWC FROM THE GILLMAN CELLAR

The project was conceived by Bill Harlan and Bob Levy of Harlan Estate - a winery that guickly became one of California's cult producers, along with the likes of Screaming Eagle. Harlan Estate sources its fruit from its own vineyards, but Harlan and Levy were interested in cultivating fruit from specific terroirs around the Napa Valley. The result was BOND (initially known as Bond Estates), which began making wine in 1997. The first commercial release came two years later.

There are five Cabernet Sauvignon wines under the main BOND banner. The fruit is sourced from sites the Harlan family have identified as being comparable to Grand Cru sites in France. These are small plots of between seven and 11 acres located around the Napa Valley.

The wines are labeled with proprietary names. The first releases in the lineup were the Melbury and Vecina wines in 1999, the St Eden followed in 2001, the Pluribus in 2003, and finally the Quella in 2006.

BOND has since received its own considerable critical recognition. Multiple wines have been rated 100 points by Robert Parker's Wine Advocate.

2012 BOND Vecina

"From an 11-acre vineyard sitting near Bond's winery and the Harlan estate, the 2012 Vecina Proprietary Red is the perfect Napa version of a hypothetical blend of a La Mission Haut-Brion and Mouton-Rothschild. This is riveting Cabernet Sauvignon with great intensity, a killer fragrance of burning embers, charcoal, gravel, blackberry, cassis and earth. Fabulously intense and full-bodied, with majestic flavor intensity, a skyscraper-like mouthfeel, incredible purity and length, and supple tannins, this magnificent wine comes closest to the great Harlan Estate itself. Drink it over the next 35 years. Drink 2015-2050." **RP 100**

2012 BOND Melbury

"The wine displays beautiful blackberry fruit, some charcoal, loamy soil undertones, forest notes, lots of spice, a fullbodied, multi-dimensional mouthfeel, and a super finish of 45+ seconds. Even in a vintage like 2012, this wine ideally needs 3-5 years of bottle age and should keep for 30+ years. Drink 2018-2048." RP 95

2012 BOND Quella

"The 2012 Quella has an opaque purple color, a gorgeous nose of white flowers, sweet blackberry and cassis fruit, and a touch of vanilla and graphite. Full-bodied, like its siblings, with great fruit extract, terrific purity and richness, and high but velvety tannins, this wine should also benefit from another 3-5 years of cellaring and keep for 30+ years. Drink 2018-2048." RP 98

2012 BOND St. Eden

"The 2012 St. Eden shows gorgeous, cedary Christmas fruitcake notes, black cherry and blackcurrant fruit, spice box, earth, and almost first growth Pauillac-like cassis and lead pencil shavings. Deep, full-bodied, and fabulously concentrated, this stunner flirts with perfection. Slightly more evolved than the Quella or Melbury, this wine may be the most drinkable out of the gate of all the Bond offerings in 2012. It should continue to evolve for at least 30+ vears. Drink 2015-2045." RP 98

2012 BOND Pluribus

"The 2012 Pluribus Proprietary Red Wine exhibits the white flowers (acacia?), blueberry and black raspberry fruit that comes from this high elevation site. It is full-bodied but very tannic, backward, coiled and relatively tight. behaving in that sense more like a 2013 than a 2012. This wine is set for a long life of 30+ years. Drink 2019-2049." RP 95+


