Château Batailley

**GRAND CRU CLASSÉ - 1855
PAUILLAC**

Château Batailley is one of the oldest Estate of Pauillac. Its name goes back to the last battle of the Hundred Year war in Medoc, it took place on the plateau that goes down to Chateau Latour. The house, remodeled during the XVIII century is surrounded by a beautiful six hectares park, designed by the famous Barillet des Champs, Napoleon III landscape-painter.

The vineyard faces the Château on a beautiful graves plateau. This great soil of fine gravel has natural drainage which makes it perfect for growing Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, and Merlot. Hand harvested with great care, vintified in a plot sized vat room, each vintage is aged in French oak barrels through the first and second year cellars. After this natural aging, wines are bottled at the Château. Wines at Chateau Batailley are dark ruby color, with an elegant bouquet, and a very good structure of ripe tannins which ensures a long life to the wine. Very well known in France as around the world, Château Batailley is served at the most prestigious tables.

Château Lynch-Moussas

GRAND CRU CLASSÉ - 1855
PAUILLAC

The Château was founded in the 18th century by a member of the Lynch Family. We can trace the origin of the "Moussas" name back to the 16th century. In 1919 the property was purchased by the Castéja family, at that time also owner of Duhart-Milon and later was inherited by Emile Castéja. Philippe Castéja, Emile Castéja's son, has been in charge of the property and its vineyards since. Château Lynch-Moussas is a typical Pauillac exhibiting a dark colour, a fruitful bouquet, a lot of softness with ripe tannins.

Château TrotteVieille

ST EMILION GD CRU
1ER GRAND CRU CLASSÉ

Its name goes back to an old Lady living in the house centuries ago. The legend wants that close down at the crossroad was a stagecoach stop, and each time a carriage called, the old Lady trotted down for news. All surrounded by walls the Estate has a charming Chartreuse with a man sized Park, and all around its beautifully kept Vineyard which is south looking, and enjoys a great view of Saint Emilion Village, and of the Dordogne Valley too. Ecologically responsible in the vineyard during the year, grapes are hand-picked incagettes, cautiously sorted, then meticulous fermentation takes place in a plot sized vat room. Wine is aged in 100% French oak new barrels, and bottled when it reaches the perfect balance that will make it able to age for decades. Chateau TrotteVieille wine is known for its minerality, roundness, freshness, and length.

Young it is full of red fruit taste, with very ripe soft tannins, balanced, and has wonderful capacity to age. This is the reason why it is particularly searched by Wine Connoisseur around the world.

An exceptionally rare particularity is that Chateau TrotteVieille the only First Growth to possess a vine plot that goes back to prephylloxera days, i.e. over a hundred years, of Cabernet Franc. They are separately picked, vinified, and every year before the last blend of bottling, 135 bottles are kept separately from the Grand Vin for memory and tasting. All 135 bottles are engraved, numbered and aged at ChateauTrotte Vieille Cellar.

Chateau TrotteVieille has always been classified First Growth since the first Saint Emilion Classification.

Barboursville is a magnificent and historic estate located between Monticello and Montpelier. It is home to Virginia's most honored winery, founded in 1976 by the Zonin Family, who have been prominent in Italian viticulture since 1821.

Defying the unanimous advice of many people to plant tobacco at Barboursville, Gianni Zonin – heir to a family wine enterprise in the Veneto – acquired Barboursville plantation with the seemingly ridiculous expectation of creating a vineyard.

Jefferson had attempted this, persisting into the 19th Century at Monticello, always failing to achieve a single harvest. He would be pleased that wine is being produced at his neighboring plantation, home to a dear friend and for whom he designed the historic mansion.

Because of Gianni Zonin and Luca Pachina, the resident winemaker since 1990, Barboursville has been drawn totally into the wine world's embrace, and inspired hundreds to follow their example. Celebrating the winery's 40th anniversary in 2016, they continue to set the standard for Virginia now populated with more than 300 wineries.

Barboursville produces Octagon, the most renowned red wine of Virginia.

Chatham Vineyards on Church Creek

The land at Chatham, which overlooks Church Creek, was patented in 1640. The Federal-period brick house, Chatham, was built in 1818. The historic outbuildings, barns and two early 1900s homes on the property have been renovated in recent years. Chatham Farm has been a working farm for four centuries.

Since 1999 more than 20 acres of high-density (1,740 vines per acre) French vinifera varieties have been planted. They are Merlot, Chardonnay and California Cabernet Franc rootstock, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot. The vineyards are cane pruned during the winter months to balance the vines and limit yields to less than four tons per acre thereby concentrating wine flavors. The grapes are handpicked and sorted before pressing to ensure the highest quality of the juice. Grapes not vinified at the winery are sold to other wineries in Virginia.

The winery was constructed in 2005 and currently has a production capacity of 3,000 to 5,000 cases annually. Temperature in the winery is maintained at 50 degrees year round. A retail tasting room is located in the winery.

King Family Vineyards is a family-owned and operated boutique winery located in Crozet, just 15 minutes from Charlottesville. The 327-acre farm was purchased by Ellen & David King in 1996. In 1998 they planted their first vines.

Sitting at the base of the Blue Ridge Mountains, the vineyard is located at 800 feet of elevation, which helps keep the grapes cool in the summer and warm in the winter. All leaf pulling, pruning, canopy maintenance, green harvesting, and harvesting in the vineyard throughout the year is tended by hand. King Family prides itself on utilizing the best management practices to avoid soil degradation.

The 2000 vintage was the first with just a few hundred cases. In 2002 the winery and tasting room building were completed and opened to the public in the fall. Today the winery produces just over 10,000 cases per year. All of the fruit comes from the Monticello American Viticulture Area (AVA), with about 88% of the grapes coming directly from the King Family's 20 acres of vines.

This year marks the fourth time the King Family Vineyards has claimed the top honor in the Virginia Governor's Cup competition (2019 Meritage), also winning in 2004, 2010 and 2018.

Thibaut-Janisson was born from a long friendship that began in a Grand Cru village in the Champagne region of France. Thibaut and his friend Manuel Janisson, both from champagne-producing families in the town, started in the family businesses at a young age. When Thibaut came to work in California in 1983, he had already spent a few years working in Australia. Thibaut arranged for Janisson to come work with him in California and the two young men began talking of one day producing a sparkling wine together. About 25 years later, they agreed that Virginia would be the place to do it.

Thibaut came to Charlottesville in 2003 to consult at Kluge Estate Winery. In 2005 after seeing the potential for Virginia sparkling wine, Thibaut and Janisson began their joint venture and in 2007 they had the first release of their nonvintage Blanc de Chardonnay. Virginia Fizz, a sparkling wine, followed in Spring 2011.

Both wines are produced at Veritas Winery in Afton, Virginia, west of Charlottesville.

In 1999 Andrew and Patricia Hobson bought Saddleback Farm near Afton, which at the time was a simple horse and cattle farm. Patricia saw the potential in the land and planted several acres of grapes with a wish and prayer. By 2001 they had their first vintage ready for production. That year Andrew tried his hand at winemaking with great success and their love for the Virginia wine industry blossomed.

Since then the Hobsons have worked tirelessly to expand on their vision. The business is truly a family affair as they have been joined by all three of their children in the running and development of the business. Their philosophy is to make wine with the classic, old-world principles of viticulture and vinication, at the same time using state of the art technology to capture varietal and regional character. Their name derives from the Roman historian Pliny the Elder's observation "In Vino Veritas" - "In Wine there is Truth." They believe that the truth in their wine comes straight from their vineyard as an expression of the land where they live and work.

The Williamsburg Winery, located on a 400-acre farm, is known as Wessex Hundred. The use of "Hundred" to name a property dates to the Colonial era and describes parcels of land sufficient to support a hundred families regardless of actual acreage.

A VIRGINIA NORTON WINE WAS EVEN NAMED "BEST RED WINE OF ALL NATIONS" AT THE VIENNA WORLD'S FAIR IN 1873, AND WAS AWARDED A GOLD MEDAL AT THE PARIS WORLD'S FAIR OF 1889 – THE YEAR THE EIFFEL TOWER WAS CONSTRUCTED.

Virginians have made wine for more than four centuries. The Jamestown settlers had hoped that Virginia would become a major source of wine for the British Empire. They signed a law that required each male settler to plant and tend at least 10 grape vines. Little came of this because every effort to grow vinifera, or vines of European origin, met with failure from an unknown pest, Phylloxera, as well as disease due to the new environment. The booming tobacco trade soon diluted British interest in the possibilities of American wine, and the American settlers themselves lost interest. While fine wine could be had only from European suppliers, whiskey, beer and brandy were plentiful.

In hopes of one day realizing the promise of fine Virginia wines, Thomas Jefferson cultivated European grapes for more than 30 years. His Monticello vineyards, however, never produced a single bottle of wine. He wasn't alone in trying. After 11 years of efforts at Mount Vernon, George Washington, too, had nothing to show for his work. In the 1820s, wines made from Native American grapes met with great success. Also, the late 1800s discovery that native and European vines could be grafted gave Virginia's nascent wine industry a lift. In the early 20th century,

Prohibition promptly brought wine production to a standstill. The industry was slow to bounce back. Some 17 years after Prohibition's repeal, Virginia still had only 15 acres of commercial wine grapes.

In the late-1950s experimental planting of vinifera showed promise. With the establishment of six new wineries in the 1970s, the recovery was officially underway. A renewed effort to grow an European Chardonnay succeeded at the Waverly Estate in Middleburg in 1973. Then in 1976, Italian pioneer vintner Gianni Zonin hired Gabriele Rausse to grow and harvest vinifera grapes near Charlottesville.

He established Barbourville Vineyards and helped other vinters do the same. By 1995 Virginia had 46 wineries, by 2005, 107. At over 300 wineries and counting, today only California, New York, Oregon and Washington have more wineries than Virginia. The persistence of generations of winemakers is paying off, and the vision of one of Virginia's most renowned native sons, Thomas Jefferson, is now coming true.

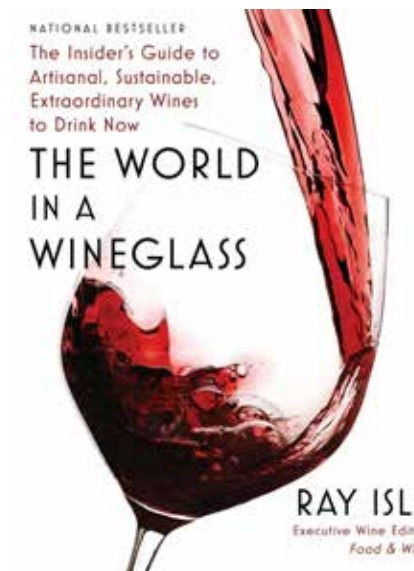

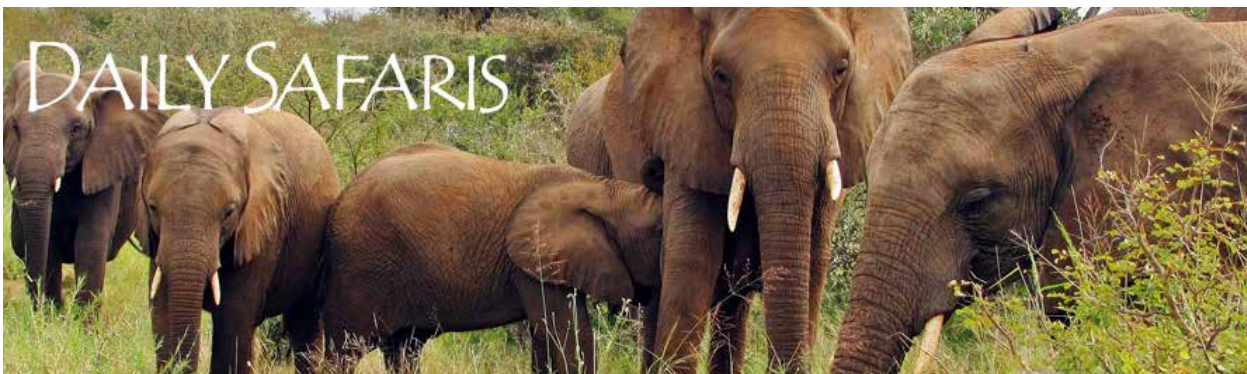
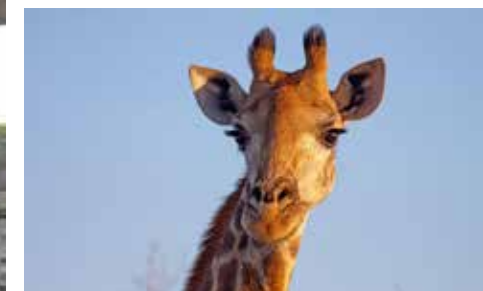

One cool November evening, eight or nine years ago, the usual gang of vinous miscreants -- Clement, Butch, Mike, Michael, Tom, Ed, Rony, Grant, and I -- had gathered around a table for gluttony and debauchery -- principally debauchery.

As usual, everyone had brought a bottle -- or two or three -- of something very dear and marvelous, together comprising the usual selection of Grange, Mouton and Lafite, Leflaive, Raveneau, Roumier, Unico, d'Yquem, and other superstars of the wine world, the world we all love so dearly.

When the time came for Clement to present his wine, we looked on with skepticism, colored perhaps with a trace of derision, as Clement produced an Oregon Pinot Noir.

And then, as we sniffed and sipped, our skepticism turned into stunned silence and awe.

This was world class Pinot Noir!

And with each minute that passed, the wine grew more glorious.

We pummeled Clement with questions! Who's the producer? Why have we never heard of him? What clones is he using? How long is the fermentation? What type of barrels does he use? How many cases are made? How the hell does he produce such transcendent juice in the Dundee Valley?

And, finally, and most important -- where can we get some?
Indeed, where can we get a lot -- a whole lot?!

Clement sat with that sly, impish smile and then he beamed, delighted at our reaction. The wine, he said, was **2009 Cameron Clos Electrique**, a wine produced from vines planted in 1984 by a man named John Paul Cameron, who was a post-doc in marine biology, but had decided there was more of a future -- and more fun -- in grapes than in plankton.

He said that John Paul was as eccentric as his bio suggested.

He noted, for example, that like a number of other great winemakers (John Thomas and Albert Grivault come quickly to mind), he never submits his wines to critics for scoring. Rather, he lets; the wines speak for themselves. (He also noted that John Paul, an art lover, had named his dog Jackson Pawlick).

We marveled at the story.

We marveled more at the wine.

Clement, dear Clement, left us so many gifts. The chime of his laughter. The light of his smile. The wellspring of his knowledge. The boundless radiance of his curiosity. The warmth and grace of his affection. And from the perspective of wine, while he shared many treasures over the years, the most lasting gift will be Cameron Pinot Noir.

The collection of same listed here represents a living history of **Cameron** and its greatness. This lot could not be reproduced today at any cost. The majority of the wines are simply unavailable. At retail or at auction.

But they are glorious. They are what California Pinot Noir wishes it could be -- all grace and harmony and elegance. And all wrapped in a cocoon of vibrant, dizzying fruit. They are, to apply the phrase the great British oenophile Michael Broadbent once used to describe a similar wine: "An iron fist in a velvet glove."

Thank you, Clement. You live on.

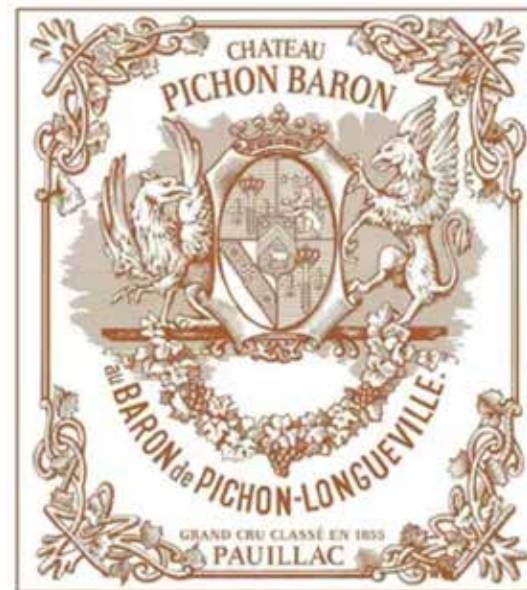

2014 Peter Michael Les Pavots Cabernet Sauvignon (1 magnum)

"The 2014 Proprietary Red Les Pavots (3,570 cases) is a blend of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc, 13% Merlot and 5% Petit Verdot aged in mostly Taransaud barrels with a small helping of Darnajou thrown in. This wine is fabulous in the vintage, although certainly less profoundly concentrated and extracted, as well as structured, compared to the 2013, which was off-the-charts fabulous. This is a brilliant wine, charming, with front-end loaded plum, blackcurrant and black raspberry fruit interwoven with graphite, tar and truffle notes. The wine has sumptuous texture, sweet, velvety tannin, and a long, full-bodied finish. It should drink well for at least two decades. Drink 2016 to 2036." **RP 95**

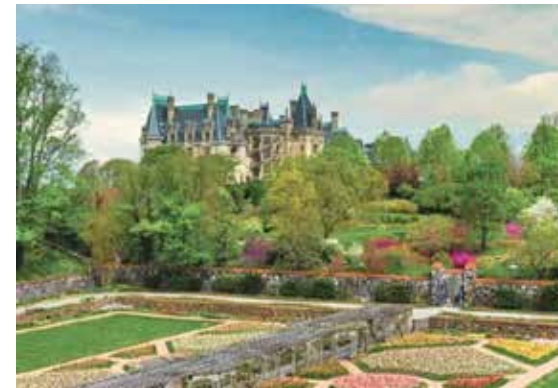
